*Important Note:* Amount to be deposited for admission: Bengali 5900/- and Chemistry 7200/-. Rest amount (if any) for the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester be deposited following the direction of the college in due course of time.

### Total no. of Seats:

### Bengali: 50 and Chemistry: 40

Selection will be made strictly in order of merit on the basis of percentage of marks. Among the total seats, 80% of seats will be reserved for WBSU students and rest 20% for the students of other Universities. However, if 80% seats reserved for home University remain unfilled; those may be filled up with the

undergraduates of other universities. Similarly, if the 20% seats reserved for the students from other universities remain unfilled; those may be filled up with the students of home university i.e. WBSU.

# **Reservation:**

Reservation Rules and Regulations are strictly followed as per West Bengal Government Rule.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

As per parent University. These are as follows:

1. Honours graduates who have passed in 10 +2+3 system or its equivalent from UGC recognized University in the year 2020, 2019 & 2018.

2. Honours graduates from recognized University in West Bengal; of the current and previous two years are eligible for admission. For students from other states, the student should have passed equivalent course as at (1) from UGC recognized University/Institute.

3. Candidates passing Honours/Major course in Arts in Under Graduate Degree level from IGNOU/NSOU and the Distance Education Programmes of other Universities in West Bengal are also eligible for admission.

4. Candidates who have appeared in other University examinations and whose results have not yet been published may also apply for the 20 % of seats.

5. Students having backlog in Part-II in one subject only and having passed in all other subjects/parts will be given opportunity to apply for PG course and if selected, will be given conditional Admission. If he/she clears the backlog in Part –II, then only he/she will be able to continue the PG course(s).

6. Each candidate should apply in a separate single application form for applying more than one subject, it any.
